

Model Home Sales Office:

303.2 Changes in level of 1/4 inch maximum in height shall be permitted to be vertical.

303.3 Changes in level greater than 1/4 inch in height and not more than 1/2 inch maximum in height shall be beveled with slope not steeper than 1:2.

303.4 Changes in level greater than 1/2 inch in height shall be by ramp complying with ICC A117.1-2017 Section 405 or by a curb ramp complying with Section 406

404.2.2 Doorways shall have a clear opening width of 32 inches minimum. Clear opening width of doorways with swinging doors shall be measure between the face of door and stop, with the door open 90 degrees.

403.5.1 The clear width of an interior accessible route shall be 36 inches minimum. The clear width of an exterior accessible route shall be 48 inches minimum.

1104.1 At least one accessible route within the site shall be provided from accessible parking, accessible passenger loading zones, and public streets or sidewalks to the accessible entrance.

1104.2 At least one accessible route shall connect accessible buildings, accessible elements and accessible spaces that are on the same site.

1104.3 Where a building or portion of a building is required to be accessible, at least one accessible route shall be provided to each portion of the building, to accessible building entrances connecting accessible pedestrian walkways and to the public way.

1106.2 At least one accessible parking space shall be provided.

1106.7 Accessible parking spaces shall be located on the shortest accessible route of travel from adjacent parking to an accessible building
